

Current best practice recommendations for COVID-19

Based on current advice, we are taking steps at Angle House Orthodontics to ensure that infection transmission risk is minimised. We respectfully request your co-operation to help us achieve this:

- Any person who is unwell refrains from attending the practice for a minimum of 14 days.
- Any person who has recently travelled overseas avoids attending the practice for 14 days.

Our patient appointment protocol is as follows:

- Please help us minimise the amount of traffic within our clinic by limiting who you bring with you to the appointment.
- Please advise reception you have arrived for your appointment.
- To assist with social distancing recommendations, we have reduced the number of seats in our waiting area. You have the option to take a seat in the waiting area or return to your car and our nurses will collect you when it is time for Dr Kataria to see you.
- All patients are to use hand sanitiser provided at the front desk or wash hands prior to entering the surgeries. Hand soap and paper towel is provided for washing hands.
